



Baccarat Tournament

Rules

The following apply to Highstakes, Lowstakes and Satellite Tournaments conducted at Grand Casino.

1. Every player must make a wager on every hand of at least the specified table minimum on either Player or Banker.
2. Baccarat will be dealt in the Style A or C format.
3. Each round will consist of at least 20 hands of Baccarat.
4. Players must place their wagers in turn in accordance of the Betting Marker.
5. If players wish to place a wager on Tie, they must first announce it and place it down before their Player or Banker wager.
6. Cards will be dealt in turn in accordance of the Betting Marker.
7. Players may only wager on their designated box.
8. Players may not lend or borrow chips.
9. Tournament chips are the property of Grand Casino and must always remain on the table.
10. All chip stacks and high denomination chips must be clear and in full view of all players.
11. Players must make up their bets first before placing them in the box.
12. Players may not dribble their chips (string-bet) into the betting area. Doing so will mean all the chips in the forward motion will be committed to the bet (unless exceeding the maximum).
13. Once bets are placed, chips cannot be added or removed (unless exceeding the table maximum).
14. When players are not present at the table to bet, the Tournament Director will flip a coin and place a bet of the table minimum from their stack. (Heads = Player & Tails = Banker).
15. Players must present all chips upon request from the Tournament Director at any time.
16. A player with less than the table minimum in chips left will be deemed to be bust out and the excess chips will not be considered in the final rankings of the chips.
17. Players may request a chip count of all/any player(s), but this will only be granted at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
18. In the event where all players on a table bust out, the person who is deemed to have busted out last will be ranked 1st of that table.
19. Players that are not active on the table are not permitted to give anyone playing any advice.
20. Only Baccarat will be dealt in its purest form, no Pairs, Tiger Bets and etc. The only betting options available will be Player, Banker and Tie.
21. Baccarat will be dealt in accordance to the rules of Baccarat contained in Division 5 of the Gazetted Rules.
22. A breach in any of the Tournament Rules may result in a player being disqualified from the tournament.
23. Tournament Director's decision is final.
